1. **Samuel Weil-1**^[1] was born about May 1773^[1]. He died on 26 Nov 1845 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1].

Esther Kahn daughter of Heyum Tüchner^[1] was born about Jan 1773^[1]. She died on 16 Jul 1844 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1].

Samuel Weil and Esther Kahn married. They had the following children:

- i. **Fanny Weil** was born between 1805-1807 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany.

 - ii. **Jacob Weil** was born in Aug 1808 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1]. He married Therese Bruell on 05 Jul 1838 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[2, 3]. He died in 1896.
 - iii. **Babette Weil**^[1] was born on 26 Mar 1817 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1].

2. **Jacob Weil-2** (Samuel-1) was born in Aug 1808 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1]. He died in 1896.

Babette Heumann daughter of Maier Heumann and Beli Berg^[1] was born about 1813 in Burgebrach, Bamberg, Bavaria, Germany^[1]. She died during childbirth on 21 Aug 1837^[1]. Beli's father was Baruch Berg^[1].

Jacob Weil and Babette Heumann were married in Jan 1835^[1]. They had the following children:

- i. **Hayum Weil**^[1] was born about 12 Sep 1828. He died on 29 Sep 1828^[1].
- ii. **Daughter Weil**^[1] was born on 01 Nov 1835 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1]. She died on 01 Nov 1835 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1].
- iii. **Daughter Weil**^[1] was born on 19 Oct 1836 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1]. She died on 19 Oct 1836 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1].

Therese Bruell daughter of Moses Bruell and Hannka Marx Guetermann^[4] was born in Mar 1815 in Lichtenfels, Bavaria, Germany^[5]. She died in 1892 in Boston, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA^[6].

Jacob Weil and Therese Bruell were married on 05 Jul 1838 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[2, 3]. They had the following children. The family immigrated to the US on 16 Sept. 1857 on SS Hammonia from Hamburg, Germany.

- i. **Martin J. Weil** was born on 27 Mar 1839 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1, 7, 8, 9, 10]. He married Malvina Rosenbach in 1866^[10]. He died on 07 Oct 1901 in New York, New York, USA^[11].
- ii. **Heinreich (Henry) J. Weil**^[1] was born on 16 May 1841 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1, 12]. He married Jane (Jennie) Adams on 31 May 1871 in Boston, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA^[13, 14]. He died on 03 Feb 1910 in Manhattan, Kings, New York, USA^[15, 16, 17, 18]. He was naturalized on 10 Oct. 1882 in Boston.

Generation 2 (con't)

- iii. **Maximilian (Max) Weil**^[1, 19] was born on 23 Jul 1843 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1, 20]. He married Gertrude Williams on 03 Oct 1869 in New York, New York, USA^[21]. He died on 05 Oct 1914 in Manhattan, Kings, New York, USA^[22, 23]. He was naturalized on 17 Dec. 1908 in New York.
- iv. **Carl (Charles) Weil**^[1] was born on 05 Jul 1845 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1, 24]. He married Caroline Sykes on 18 Feb 1874 in New York, New York, USA^[25]. He died on 13 Nov 1906 in Boston, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA^[26]. He was naturalized on 12 Sept. 1896 in Boston.
- v. **Emilie Weil** was born on 26 Apr 1847 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[10, 27]. She married Jacob Dreyfus in 1867 in Manhattan, Kings, New York, USA.
- vi. **Helena (Helene) Weil**^[1] was born on 30 May 1850 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[10, 28, 29, 30, 31]. She married Isaac Kaffenburgh on 26 May 1872 in Boston, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA. She died on 23 Nov 1922 in Rhode Island, USA^[32].
- vii. **Sigmund (Samuel) Weil**^[1] was born on 22 Aug 1852 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[33, 34]. He married Charlotte Cone in 1879^[10]. He was naturalized on 13 Oct. 1883 in Boston, MA.
- viii. **Fanny Weil**^[1] was born on 10 Jun 1854 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1]. She died on 13 Jul 1855 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1].
- ix. **August Weil**^[1] was born on 18 Jun 1857 in Untermerzbach, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany^[1, 35]. He married Emma Shuman in 1884^[10]. He died on 26 Oct 1907 in Boston, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA^[36].

- 13 Passport application - 1925, Jennie wrote that she was married on May 31, 1871 in Boston.
- 14 Boston Archive, Marriage Intention filed on May 27, 1871. However, the archive does not have a record of the actual marriage.
- 15 Passport application - 1925, Jennie Weil's passport application said that she was a widow since 1910. Also stated that Henry was born in Switzerland which is a mistake.

- 16 Passport application - 1920, The 1920 passport application of Richard Weil stated that Henry had lived in Boston and NY and had died in 1910.
- 17 Jewishgen.org, The Boston Jewish Advocate Obituary Database on jewishgen.com gave date of death as February 11, 1910.
- 18 Death certificate, New York City #3977.
- 19 Leo von Euler, Some data on Max family, names and dates, has been provided by Leo von Euler, husband of Mary von Euler, who apparently is related to Alma Ehrich.
- 20 Naturalization Petition, gave date of birth.
- 21 International Geogologic Index, gave date and place of marriage.
- 22 Leo Sender, gave date and place of death.
- 23 NY Death certificate # 28904.
- 24 Passport application - 1906, Gave birth date as 7/5/1845 in Bavaria. Also naturalized citizen on Sept 12, 1896 in Boston. However, in the passport application of 1873, he swears that he is a naturalized citizen.
- 25 A Chronicle of Boston Jewry by A. Ehrenfried, Gave date and location of marriage on page 624.
- 26 Jewishgen.org, in Boston death records, the date is 11/16/1906.
- 27 Census 1870 - Boston, Age in census is 23, so birth would be in 1847.
- 28 MA archives, Marriage license issued in May 1872, says that she is 21: thus born in 1851.
- 29 Lisa Lopez - 2008, Lisa gave date as 5/13/1852.
- 30 Helene Weil Headstone, gave year of birth as 1850.
- 31 Passport application - 1896, Issac stated in his passport application that his wife was born on May 13, 1836. The month and day may be correct, but the year is not.
- 32 Rhode Island Death Index, date Nov. 23, 1922, and she was a widow.
- 33 Census 1900 - NY, This source provided birth months for Samuel, Charlotte, and 2 children as well as names and birth months for Charlotte's parents, spelling of her maiden name, and years married.
- 34 Passport application - 1894, Confirmed: date and place of birth. Immigration. Became naturalized citizen on 13 Oct 1883 in Boston.
- 35 Passport applications 1896, 1899, 1904, The 1896 application specifically stated that he was born on June 12, 1857 in Altenkunstadt, Germany and immigrated from Germany in 1857. The 1899 and 1904 applications stated that he was 6 weeks old when he immigrated.
- 36 Jewishgen.org, Someone entered dates on August and wife Emma Shuman, as well as their child. Sent message.

Other Information from the German Summaries

Occupations:

Samuel Weil was a Handelsmann or tradesman

Jacob Weil was a Viehhändler, Seifensiedermeister (Sic) or Cattle Dealer and Soap Maker

Maier Heumann was a Handelsmann or tradesman.

The Weil families lived in house #39 in Untermerzbach, which is now #7 Neubaustrasse: Samuel (from 1817 on) and Jacob (from 1836 with Babette and from 1839 with Therese). Previously, (from 1835-36) Jacob and Babette lived in house #31, which is now Marketplatz 7.

All of the children of Jacob and Therese were born in house #39 (contrary to what August wrote in his passport applications).

All the children of Jacob and Babette are buried in the Jewish cemetery in Ebern, Hassberge, Bavaria, Germany. Cordula thinks that Samuel and Esther are buried in Untermerzbach, but cannot identify a headstone (maybe in Hebrew).
